Main Motion C: Executive Board

**Whereas,** The minimum requirement to run for an IRHA Executive Board position is obscure,

**Whereas,** Allowing a letter of intent and a letter of support would streamline the process and remove barriers of running,

**Therefore, let it be resolved that,**

Article VII Bidding, Election, Vacancy and Removal and Office

**Section I Bidding**

A. The Bid shall include the following:

1. Name and position bidding for:
  - a. President
  - b. Vice President of Finance and Administration
  - c. Vice President of Recognition and NRHH
  - d. Coordinator of IT Services
  - e. Public Relations Officer
  - f. Advisor(s)
2. Current institution, past institution and community activities, accomplishments and involvement.
3. Goals for IRHA, the position and the plan for accomplishing these goals.
4. Qualifications for the position.
5. Financial support for the position:
  - a. Housing Office
  - b. Campus' Residence Hall Government
  - c. Etc.
6. Letters of Support from one of the following:
  - a. Campus Residence Hall Government
  - b. Advisor
  - c. Professional Housing Staff Member
7. A bid is not required for a position but is highly recommended.
- ~~8. If a bid is not submitted, a formal letter with advisor approval is required.~~

**B. If a bid is not submitted the candidate will submit each of the following:**

1. A proclamation of intent including, but not limited to the following:
  - a. Name
  - b. Position Sought
  - c. Relevant Experience(s) and Biographical Information
  - d. Goals for the Position and the Organization
2. No less than one letter of financial support from the host institution for the position:



- a. Housing Office
- b. Campus' Residence Hall Government
- c. Etc.
